CHANGES TO ENROLMENT REQUIREMENTS FOR IRAMOO PRIMARY SCHOOL

Dear Parent/Guardian,

You are no doubt aware that many schools in Victoria including several in Wyndham are under significant enrolment pressures because of the increasing number of families wishing to enrol their children.

Our school has developed an excellent reputation and is very much a 'school of choice' for many Wyndham families, so much so that we are over our official 'enrolment capacity' with in excess of 780 students this year and as a result we are now only accepting enrolments from within our Designated Neighbourhood Area (DNA). This information was first communicated to all current Iramoo families in writing on 03/08/2016.

- **We will continue to enrol every student who lives permanently within our Designated Neighbourhood Area (i.e. Iramoo is their closest government school).**
- We can no longer accept the enrolment of siblings of current students *who are not living permanently within our Designated Neighbourhood Area.*

The number of students enrolled at Iramoo has increased significantly in recent years with approximately 635 Prep enrolments since 2013 and only 390 Grade 6 students leaving during the same period. In addition, data held by the Department of Education & Training shows that we have over 200 students currently attending Iramoo who live in the Designated Neighbourhood Area of Wyndham Vale Primary School and 64 who are in the DNA of Manor Lakes College as well as a number of others living as far away as Hoppers Crossing and Tarneit. Clearly our school will become severely overcrowded if we continue to enrol students who live outside our DNA. The Department of Education & Training predicts that we will have over 930 students by 2020 if we do not restrict our enrolment to those living within our DNA *only*.

We have a number of families with children currently attending our school who do not live within our DNA and who have pre-school aged children that they may have planned to enrol at Iramoo. *These families will need to enrol their younger children at the school closest to their home.*

To enrol a child at Iramoo all parents now need to provide:

- The child's birth certificate and
- Immunisation History Statement and
- **Two documents for proof of the child's permanent residential address**, either:**
 - Contract of sale/title document/rates notice (for home owners)
 - OR**
 - Rental agreement (for tenants)
 - OR**
 - Any *current* Centrelink related document e.g. health care card
 - OR**
 - A *current* document from the Australian Taxation Office
 - AND**
 - One other *current* piece of evidence such as driving licence or utilities bill.

Please note that regardless of address, no current student will be required to transfer from Iramoo and that we will continue to enrol every child who lives permanently within our Designated Neighbourhood Area as required by the Victorian Department of Education & Training.
