LIBRARY

Our Prep children will begin to borrow books the week beginning ***Monday, March 4***. They will visit our school library every second week. To borrow from our library children are required to have a library bag. If you have not yet sent your child's library bag to school, we ask that you please do so ready for borrowing. If you are having trouble finding a suitable library bag, the red bags that the children received at the start of the school year would be ideal.



SCHOOL NURSING PROGRAM

The School Nursing Program offers all families a free health assessment for children in their first year at school. A registered school nurse with expertise in the areas of child health and development is employed to carry out health assessments of children in grade Prep. This service can assist in the early identification of health problems and offer advice, information and (if appropriate) referral on to other services if health concerns are identified. The School Nurse will visit Iramoo Primary School early in Term 2. If you have not already done so, please complete the School Entrant Health Questionnaire sent home earlier this term and return it to the office as soon as possible.

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST (OT)

Our school employs an Occupational Therapist to support children with social, emotional, sensory, physical and other personal needs. Our OT will be working with children who have been identified by the school as requiring additional support. During Term 1 our OT will be visiting each of the Prep classes to identify children who may require additional support. If your child is identified as requiring OT support you will be contacted by the school for further discussion and to provide you written consent. There is no cost to families for this service.
