Last week our staff were contacted by the management of the Maldon Blue Light Camp where our Grade 4 students have been going for almost 10 years. The very disappointing news we received is that they can only accommodate a maximum of 100 students per camp. We currently have 123 students in Grade 4.

One of the suggestions made by the camp is that we take the first 100 students who return their deposit and the other students miss out. That suggestion won't be considered at our school.

The other alternative is that we divide our group in half and take two camps, as close together as possible.

The only vacancies the camp has that would meet our requirements are:

OPTION A

Monday, May 1 to Wednesday, May 3 **and** Monday, May 8 to Wednesday, May 10

OR

OPTION B

Monday, December 11 to Wednesday, December 13 **and** Wednesday, December 13 to Friday, December 15

This dilemma is yet another one of the challenges of having a school that is well over enrolment capacity with several hundred children enrolled from outside our designated neighbourhood area.
