Dear Parent/Guardian,

This year the Grade 4 camp will again be held at the Victorian Blue Light Youth Camp in the historic town of Maldon from **Monday, May 1 – Wednesday, May 3, (Grades 4CP & 4SF)** and from **Monday, May 8 – Wednesday, May 10, (Grades 4AM & 4KB)**. The focus of the camp will be Bike Education and pupils will get many opportunities to ride during their time away.

Whilst at camp, the children will participate in a range of exciting activities such as BMX riding, mini golf and bushwalking. They will also get the chance to ride to an old gold mine and visit an old fashioned sweet shop.

The cost of the camp will be **\$220 per child**. A part payment scheme is being made available to enable you to pay the amount in 3 instalments, you may however pay in one lump sum.

If you want your child to attend camp please complete the attached form and return it with a **\$70 non-refundable deposit** to your child’s teacher by **Friday, March 24**. Please indicate below if you wish to pay the remainder in full or in 2 instalments. **Camp must be paid in full by Friday, April 21**.

Please note that a camp **Information Evening will be held from 5 p.m. - 5.45 p.m. on Monday, March 27**, where more details will be given and any questions you may have can be answered. With this note you have also received information about the camp including a Confidential Medical Form and a checklist of what your child will need to bring to camp.

WHAT TO BRING FOR CAMP

The following is provided as a guide to camper's requirements:

- Pillow, sleeping bag or sheets and doona
- Toiletries – towel, toothpaste etc.
- Underwear – one pair for each day plus one spare
- Socks (anklet socks not recommended)
- Warm pyjamas
- Jumpers/windcheaters
- Sneakers/walking boots
- Slippers for inside (carpeted rooms are a '**no shoes**' zone)
- Plastic bag for dirty or wet clothes
- Torch with extra set of batteries for night walks
- Waterproof jacket or coat
- **APPROVED** bicycle helmet
- Cameras are permitted but no responsibility will be accepted if damaged or lost.

Please note: The following items are **NOT** to be brought to camp:

- Mobile phones
- iPods/iPads
- MP3 players
- Hand-held digital games
- **CHEWING GUM IS STRICTLY BANNED**
- **AEROSOL CANS ARE STRICTLY BANNED**

Dear Parent/Guardian,

The last payment for the Grade 4 camp is due on **Friday, April 21**. Thank you to all of the families who have been making regular payments over the past few weeks. A second copy of our '*what to bring*' list has been included for you on the back of this note so that your child is able to bring the appropriate clothes and equipment to camp. **Children must bring their approved bicycle helmet to camp.** It is a good idea for your child to assist with their own packing so that they know what they have in their suitcase and which items belong to them. It also helps to **label ALL items** so that we can return any that may become misplaced. It is important that all children bring clothing that is warm and practical, as they will spend much of their time participating in active outdoor tasks.

Please note on this list, the items children are **not** allowed to bring e.g. **electrical equipment**. Digital cameras are acceptable to take but must be the responsibility of the individual student. There is no compensation for any loss or damage to children's property.

There are still a small number of medical forms that have not been returned – please complete your child's form carefully and return it to school by **Friday, April 21** if you have not already done so. **Children will not be able to attend camp without a fully completed medical form.** Spare copies of the medical form are available from our school office.

On the morning of **Monday, May 1**, students from **Grades 4CP & 4SF** should arrive at school at the usual time and assemble in the central area of the BER. Students who require medication must have an adult accompany them in giving the medication directly to **Mrs Cheryl Pantelidis**. The \$5 which students are allowed to bring for the Maldon lolly shop must be handed to **Mr Ian Stokes** in an envelope labelled with the student's name and grade. Any money over \$5 will be returned to the parent/guardian.

On the morning of **Monday, May 8**, students from **Grades 4AM & 4KB** should arrive at school at **7.30 a.m.** and assemble in the central area of the BER. The reason for this early gathering time is because we will be leaving for camp at **8 a.m.** and our Grade 6 camp will be leaving at approximately 9 a.m. the same day. We do not want to mix up luggage, buses or children! Students who require medication must have an adult accompany them in giving the medication directly to **Mrs Sandra Cameron**. The \$5 which students are allowed to bring for the Maldon lolly shop must be handed to **Miss Alisha Jessop** in an envelope labelled with the student's name and grade. Any money over \$5 will be returned to the parent/guardian.

Each child is required to **bring a packed lunch and a drink for the first day of camp**. Children are **not allowed** to bring food into their accommodation so please **ensure that any containers or bags that your child has for lunch can be thrown away afterwards**.
