The workshop was held in our Visual Arts room and was led by a specialist tutor. Students learnt basic hand-building techniques and personalised their mugs using colourful underglazes, demonstrating wonderful creativity and enthusiasm throughout the session.

Each mug will now be bisque fired, professionally glazed, glaze fired and individually boxed before being returned to the school. Once completed, the mugs will be proudly displayed as part of our Book Week Art Show, showcasing our students' creativity and craftsmanship.

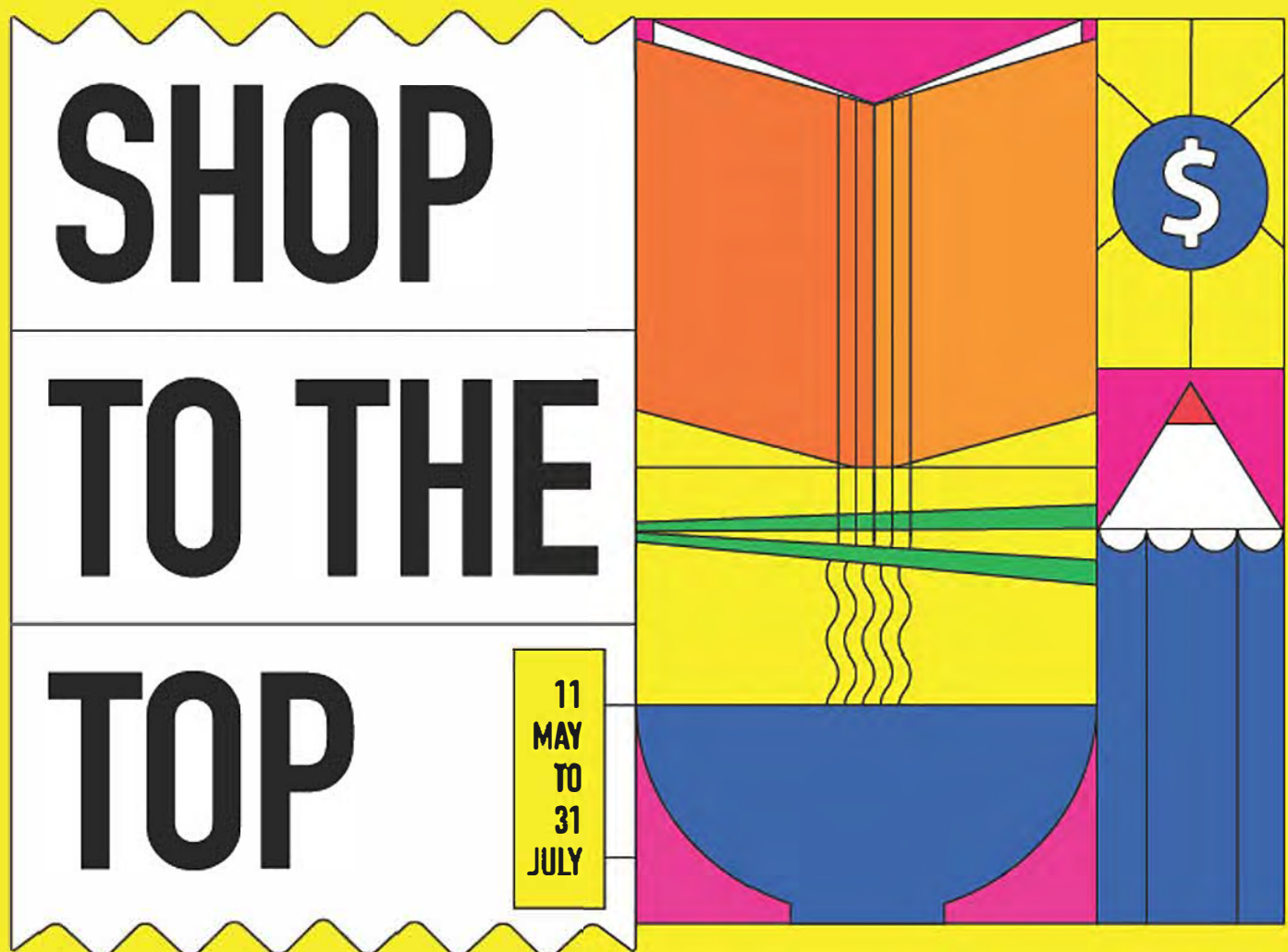

2027 PREP ENROLMENT

We are currently taking enrolments for 2027 Prep. If you, your friends or neighbours have a child who will be 5 years old before the end of April 2027, please encourage them to enrol at their local neighbourhood school as soon as possible.

Please email your supporting documents to iramoo.ps@education.vic.gov.au or bring the following documents into our office:

- The child's Birth Certificate (front and back)
- Immunisation History Statement
- Two documents for proof of the child's permanent residential address**, either:
 - Contract of sale/title document/rates notice (for homeowners) or
 - Rental agreement provided by a real estate agent (for tenants) or
 - Any current Centrelink related document e.g. health care card or
 - A current document from the Australian Taxation Office along with one other current piece of evidence such as a utilities bill (eg. gas/electricity).

Please note that documents must be original or certified copies.

**Statutory declarations will not be accepted, and no enrolment will proceed without the required documentation.
