Financial Support for Families

Iramoo Primary School understands that some families may experience financial difficulty and offers a range of support options so that children do not miss out. These include:

- the Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF)
- payment plans
- individual payment plans

CSEF

Families holding a valid means-tested concession card or temporary foster parents are eligible to apply for the Camps, Sports and Excursions (CSEF) funding - \$125.00 per child. This money can be used to help cover the costs of camps, excursions, incursions and/or swimming. CSEF applications are open from the first day of Term 1, 2023. Parents or legal guardians are required to submit a new CSEF application form each year.

CURRICULUM CONTRIBUTIONS

Although the Government provides a grant for children's books and other supplies each year, it is not enough to cover all of our essential student learning items.

Our School Council makes a decision each year on what the amount will be. For 2023, \$120 per child is required.

At Iramoo Primary School, these items are purchased by the school and provided to **every** student.

Stationery	All essential stationery items including: Workbooks, pencils, reading diaries, glue, textas etc.	\$50
Classroom Projects	Bulk consumable materials / supplies for items produced in class such as: models and other creative designs including Science projects	\$20
Specialist Programs <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Visual Arts - Performing Arts - Phys. Ed - Language Other Than English (LOTE) 	During specialist classes, students will print or produce projects and experiment with a range of materials, while exploring these areas. Items may include consumable materials such as clay, cardboard and decorative supplies (i.e. glitter, feathers and stick on adornments). Students may also create their own costumes for special performances.	\$30
Online Subscriptions	Online access to a range of educational applications such as Reading Eggs, Matific, Scratch, Duolingo	\$20
